



Local Elections 2026 – London Living Streets local groups: shared asks

1. Reducing road danger

- Develop a borough plan to meet Vision Zero (in line with Mayor of London targets)
- Compliance with speed limits of 20mph (or lower)
- Higher charges (inc. parking) for larger vehicles (e.g. SUVs) and oversized cars
- Press Mayor of London to reduce numbers of large lorries in the borough.

2. Pavements & parking

- Removal of pavement parking
- Kerbside strategies with targets on reallocating parking spaces to play, trees, seating, parklets and rain gardens
- Remove parking on bus routes
- Pavement quality – clutter free, even and fully accessible pavements.

3. Traffic Reduction

- Expand school streets to create school zones
- Low traffic neighbourhoods/healthy neighbourhoods roll out.

4. High Streets & Crossings

- Lobby TfL for pedestrian phases on all arms of signalised junctions
- Ensure crossing times allow enough time to pedestrians to cross
- Pilot and roll-out side road Zebra crossings.
- Tackling drivers who block pedestrian crossings.

5. Walking networks

- Potential to create high quality walking networks connecting key local amenities and destinations (ref. Footways work (<https://footways.london/>)).
